

# CDBA Summer Clash Hotels

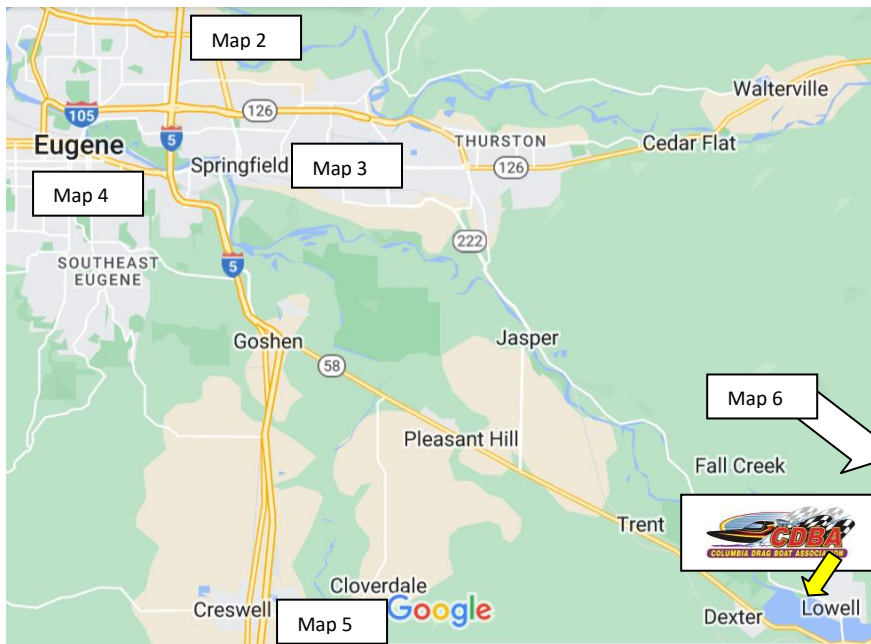
Here are some hotel offerings for CDBA's July Summer Clash with in 20-30 minutes of the track at Lowell State Park. I searched "Hotels" in Google Maps for July 13-16 and this is what popped up with availabilities. This is as of June 28<sup>th</sup>. Please do your due diligence to make sure a lower priced hotel is in neighborhood you're comfortable with.

In addition to these hotels, there are Airbnb.com multi-bed rentals within similar driving time to the track ranging from \$118 to \$300 a night plus fees.

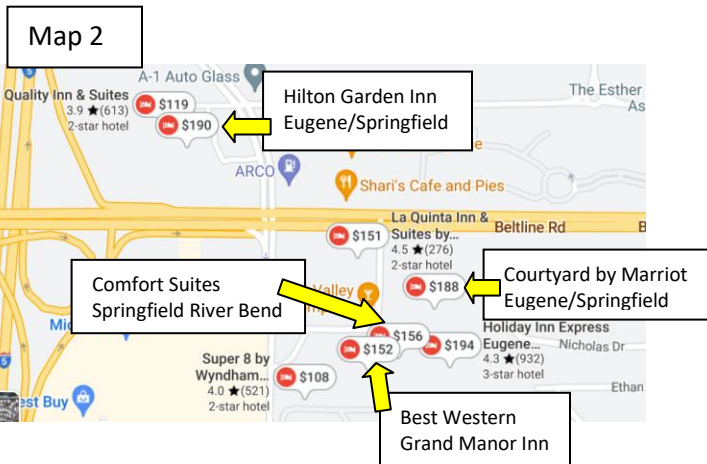

First, a map of the general Area.

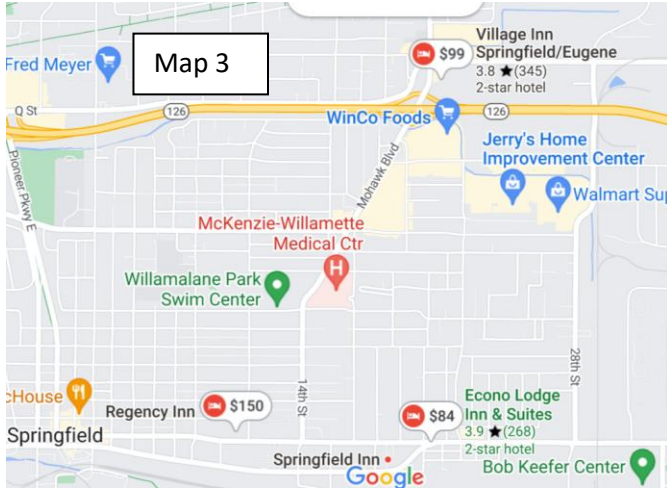


- General Driving time to the track at Lowell State Park.

  - Oakridge (Map 6)- 26 Minutes



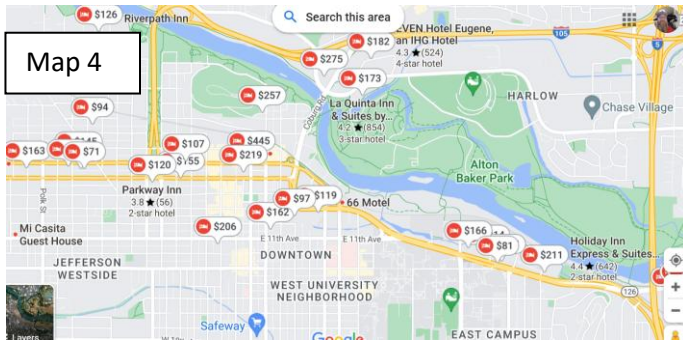
- Map 2- At the I-5 to Beltline Interchange near several restaurants, the Gateway Mall, and short driving distance to the Valley River Center Mall.
- You can take the Highway to the lake, or come the back way through Springfield.

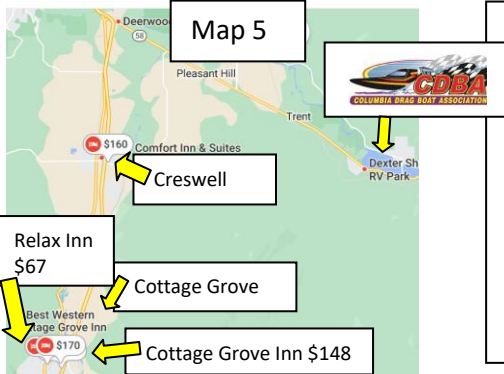
**Map 3- Springfield**

**Map 4- Eugene near University of Oregon.**

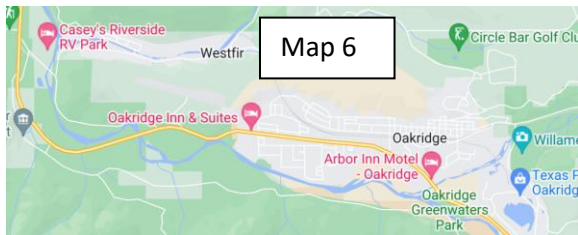
